While you are on this Camel safari tour you visit places of tourist and historical interest in Mandawa, Bikaner, Jaisalmer, Ludharva, Chatrayil, Moolsagars and many other places...all on camel back!

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 01

On the first day of the tour you arrive at Delhi where the India tourist and tour guide receives you and takes you to the hotel where you check in. You stay at the hotel overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 02

On the 2nd day the tour package includes a tour of the tourist destinations in Delhi. You visit the Humayun's Tomb, Qutab Minar and the Laxmi Narayan temple. Apart from these places you also visit the buildings that house the offices of the Government of India. You come back to the hotel and have your lunch and then the tour itinerary includes a tour of the historical monuments in Old Delhi. You visit the Jama Masjid, the Gandhi Memorial and the Red Fort. After an entire days tour you come back to the hotel. You stay overnight at the hotel.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 03

On the morning of the 3rd day the tour itinerary includes a drive to Mandawa, Rajasthan, India. Once you reach Mandawa you check in to the hotel. The tour package includes an afternoon tour to the ancient haveli's with their artistically painted walls. The walls of these havelis are decorated with murals and frescoes. After an entire days tour you come back to the hotel. You stay overnight at the hotel.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 04

On the morning of the 4th day the tour package includes a drive to Bikaner, Rajasthan, India. On your arrival at Bikaner the India tourist and tour guide helps you check in to the hotel. In the afternoon the tour package includes tour of Bikaner. You visit places of tourist interest such as the Junagadh fort and the Jain temples. After an exciting tour of Bikaner you come back to the hotel and stay overnight at the hotel.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 05

On the morning of the 5th day you are free to enjoy a city tour of Bikaner on your own. In the afternoon the tour package includes a drive to Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, India. Once you reach Jaisalmer you check in to the hotel. You stay at the hotel overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 06

On the 6th day of the Camel safari tour you begin your tour on camel back after your breakfast. Your tour to Badabagh in Rajasthan, India takes you on a tour of the royal cenotaphs of the Bhatti Rajput Kings. Your camel caravan stops at the tiny village of Baisakhai where you have your lunch and visit an ancient Hindu temple. Your camel safari continues and you proceed to Ramkunda, you go on tours to a number of ancient temples in this part of Rajasthan, India. You camp overnight at Ramkunda and

have dinner and stay in tents.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 07 - Ramkunda - Roopse - Ludharva -Chatrayil

On the 7th day your Camel safari tour continues after breakfast and you travel to Ludharva and visit Roopse, a rustic village with houses made of mud and sticks. You stop for lunch at Ludharva and the tourist and tour guide arranges for you to visit the Jain temple in the region. Your camel safari tour continues and you travel to Chatrayil, a tiny village with a predominantly Muslim population. Your camel caravan reaches Peerawal, Rajasthan, India. You camp at Peerawal and have dinner and stay overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 08

On the 8th day of your camel safari tour you have breakfast at Peerawal and your camel caravan travels to Salkha. This is a traditional Rajasthani Rajput village you stop here and have lunch and then travel towards the Sand dunes. You reach a place called Beri of Kanoi; this place is known for its water wells. Ladies trying to balance several water pots on their heads is a common sight in this region. Once your camel caravan reaches the sand dunes you set camp in the area and have dinner while enjoying desert folk music and folk dances around the campfire.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 09

On the 9th day of your camel safari tour you have breakfast at the camp and then the camel caravan moves towards Masoordi. On the way you visit Kanoi a traditional Rajasthani carpenters village. Once your camel caravan reaches Masoordi you have lunch and then proceed to Jeseiri a water tank that is basically an Oasis. You set camp near this water tank and stay here overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 10

On the 10th day the tour package includes breakfast and travel to Deegasar and visit Dedha on the way. You have lunch at Deegasar and then the camel caravan continues. You travel to Kuldhara stopping at a small village Dhani for sometime. Once you reach Kuldhara the India tourist and tour guide arranges for you to go on a tour of this village and see the lifestyle of the local people. You set camp in this village and stay here overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 11

On the 11th day the camel safari tour continues and your camel caravan takes you to Jaisalmer on the way you visit Moolsagar and Amarsagar. Once you arrive at Jaisalmer you check in to the hotel. You are free to spend the rest of the day as you please. You stay overnight at the hotel.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 12

On the 12th day the tour package includes an entire days tour of Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, India. You tour tourist destinations such as the Patwon Ki Haveli, Gadi Sagar tank, Salim Singh Ki Haveli and the Museum. You stay overnight at the hotel

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 13

On the 13th day the tour package includes a drive to Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India. Once you reach Jodhpur you check in to the hotel. You are free to go on a sightseeing tour of the city. You stay at the hotel overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 14

You go on a sightseeing tour of Jodhpur on the 14th day. You visit tourist destinations such as the Mehrangarh fort, Jaswant Thada and the Clock Tower. There are a number of palaces, pavilions and other structures within the Mehrangarh Fort. There is a museum inside the fort. After your tours to the

places of tourist interest you come back to the hotel. You stay overnight at the hotel.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 15

On the 15th day the tour package includes a drive to Jaipur, Rajasthan, India. Once you reach Jaipur you check in at the hotel. You are free to spend the day on your own. You stay at the hotel overnight.

The Camel Safari Tour - Day 16

On the 16th day you go on a tour of the Jaipur city. You visit the Amber fort on elephant back. You also go on tours to the Johari Bazaar, Hawa Mahal and the Royal Observatory and the City Palace. You stay overnight at the hotel.

On the 17th day the tour package includes a drive back to Delhi. You check in to the hotel. After dinner the India tourist and tour guide takes you to the airport so that you can board your flight home.
